- **Committee Meetings:** Thursday, June 8th with Finance at 3:30 PM and Pastoral at 4:30 PM.
- **DCCW are sponsoring Pack the Food drive** where they need donations as well as volunteers to pack 50,000 nutritious meals for children and families in developing countries. It is Saturday, August 12th at the Walton Co Fair Grounds in DeFuniak Springs. They have two shifts and need 75 volunteers for each shift. The Diocese is partnering with Cross Catholic outreach. You can scan the QR code to donate and to sign up to work, on the poster in the vestibule.
